

Knowledge:

Special Places: Different religions have special places where people feel close to God, like churches, mosques, synagogues, and temples.

The Promised Land: A special place God promised to Moses and His people, where they could live in peace and worship God freely.

Worship: Worship is an important way for people to show love and respect to God. This can happen in special places or anywhere people feel close to God.

Holy: Something very special and pure, often related to God or a place of worship.


Promised Land: A special place God promised to His people, where they could live safely and happily.






Community

Key Text:

The Bible: The holy book for Christians, which tells the stories of Jesus, Moses, and other important people.

The Torah: The holy book for Jewish people, which includes the story of Moses leading the Israelites out of Egypt. "Let my people go, so that they may worship me" (Exodus 8:1). This is found in both the Torah and the Bible.

The Qur'an: The holy book for Muslims, which also tells the story of Moses (known as Musa in Arabic) and how he led his people with God's guidance. "We inspired Moses: 'Throw your staff,' and at once it devoured what they falsified!" (Qur'an 7:117).



Key People

Jesus: Jesus is very special because Christians believe he is the Son of God. He taught people about love and kindness.

Moses: Moses is important because he helped free God's people from slavery in Egypt and led them to a special place called the Promised Land.

The Disciples: These were Jesus' close friends who followed him and helped spread his teachings.

Pharaoh: The ruler of Egypt who did not want to let God's people go until God sent many signs to show His power.
