**"Whatever you do in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him."**

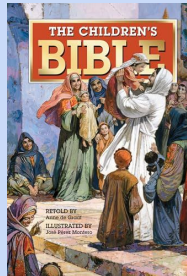

Christians believe that **Jesus' resurrection** shows that there is eternal life and that God's love is stronger than anything.



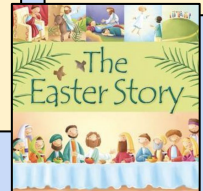
