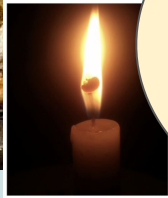


Human and Social Sciences is about learning why people live the way they do, like, "Why do people celebrate different religious holidays/festivals?"

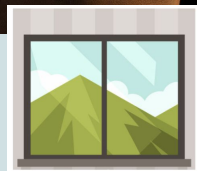
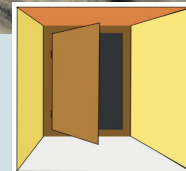

Spirituality - questions to prompt spiritual thinking



How can your spirit shine in the way you treat others?

How do you feel when you think about the connection between your spirit and the world around you?

What do you think makes you feel truly connected to others?

Theology - example questions

Is there anything in this painting that makes you think about something mysterious or spiritual?

If this painting were a prayer or a message to God, what do you think it would say?



What might this painting be telling us about the unseen or the divine?

How does this painting help you think about the big questions of life, like why we are here or what our purpose is?

What do you imagine the people in the painting are feeling or thinking about their relationship with God or the universe?

What part of this painting makes you wonder about the existence of something greater than ourselves?

If you could add something to this painting to show a connection with God and His believers, what would it be?

Theology - world faith example questions: Islam



How do you think this painting reflects the beauty of Allah's creation?

What parts of this painting remind you of something you've learnt about Allah or the Quran?

How does this painting make a believer feel closer to Allah or help them think about their faith?

If this painting could tell a story from the Quran, which story do you think it would be?

What does this painting teach us about the importance of prayer or worship in Islam?



What elements in this painting might symbolise something spiritual in Islam, like peace or purity?

How does this painting help a believer think about being grateful to Allah?

What do you think this painting is saying about the connection between people and Allah?

How does this painting help you think about the presence of Allah in believers everyday lives?

If a believer could add something to this painting to show their love for Allah, what do you think it would be?

If this painting could ask you a question about your faith or beliefs, what do you think it would ask?

How does this painting help you think about how we should treat others in our community?

What might this painting be telling us about the importance of kindness and justice in Islam?

Do you think this painting is showing something about how some Muslims live their lives?

What does this painting make you wonder about the purpose of life in Islam?

How could this painting help someone reflect on the values they should uphold as part of their faith?

What aspects of this painting might inspire a believer to deepen their connection with their community?

How could the scene in this painting influence a believer to act more compassionately or justly in their life?



How do you think this painting/image could inspire someone to live out their faith more fully?

What does this painting/image show about how a believer might practise their faith in daily life?

How might this painting encourage someone to show kindness and care to others in their community?

In what ways could this painting/picture remind a believer to follow their religious teachings in how they treat others?

How might a believer use the message of this painting/picture to guide their actions and decisions?
