Music at The Blue School

Private Music Lessons for Pupils in Years 3 - 6

Pupils from Years 3 to 6 can take private music lessons for one instrument during the school day. The costs for the 2026-2027 school year are as follows:

- **Individual 20-minute lesson:** £159 per term for 10 lessons + £3 admin fee **£162**
- **Individual 30-minute lesson:** £238 per term for 10 lessons + £3 admin fee **£241**
- **Group 30-minute lesson:** £119 per term for 10 lessons + £3 admin fee **£121**

Group lessons consist of no more than two students.

These lessons are primarily taught by highly qualified teachers from Hounslow Music Services. Payments for lessons are made via Arbor under Clubs.

Please note: Children will not be allowed to continue with music lessons if there are any outstanding fees from the previous term.

Once lessons are booked, you must pay for the full term, even if your child decides to discontinue.

Refunds or rescheduling are not available if your child is absent due to illness or school trips.

Available Instruments: Drums, Piano, Violin, Brass, Guitar

Instruments are available for hire from Hounslow Music Services. Details can be found on the Hounslow Music website. Instruments must be collected in person from Hounslow, and children need to be present for sized instruments.

How to Book: To book lessons, please contact our Music Team via email at music@theblueschool.com with your child's name and class, your preference for group or individual lessons, the lesson length, and your instrument choice.

Terms and Conditions:

- Lessons are booked for full terms, and we assume your child will continue unless we receive half a term's notice.

Important Term Dates and Cancellation Deadlines:

- **Autumn Term:** Notice to cancel **by 13th Nov.** for the Spring Term
- **Spring Term:** Notice to cancel **by 12th Feb.** for the Summer Term.
- **Summer Term:** Notice to cancel **by 11th June** for the New Academic Year (Please note that parents of **Year 6 pupils leaving the school at the end of this academic year** do not need to submit a cancellation request, as music lessons will automatically conclude)

Charges are added to Arbor after 14th November, 14th February, and 14th June.

Final payments are due 1st December for the Spring term, 1st March for the Summer term, and 1st July for the following Autumn term.

If a child misses a lesson (e.g., due to illness or a school trip), the lesson will not be made up.

If a teacher is unavailable, lessons will either be rescheduled or refunded if no alternative date can be found.

Communication with music teachers is through the 'yellow book' provided by HMS. Teachers provide weekly updates and practice instructions in this book. They do not share their email addresses.

Instruments must be rented ([HMS](#)) or bought privately.
